Distance Education Scholarships available for Spring enrollment

The Western Iowa Regents Resource Center is offering \$1,000 scholarships to eligible students who enroll in a distance education program at one of Iowa's public universities. This amount effectively covers the cost of one undergraduate course. Certain programs at the University of Northern Iowa may be eligible for a larger tuition reduction. Interested individuals should contact one of our transfer specialists at the bottom of this newsletter to determine eligibility and to apply by December 20, 2023.

We are pleased to have already awarded six scholarships for Spring 2024. Among the awardees are Angela Sewalson (pursuing an MA in Strategic Communication) and Mike Cagley (pursuing an EdD: Education Policy & Leadership).



University of Northern Iowa Elementary Education on the Western Iowa Tech campus



The University of Northern Iowa and Western Iowa Tech Community College have reached an agreement to provide seamless Elementary Education support to area residents. Dr Monaliza Chian is an Elementary Education instructor from the University of Northern Iowa who will be teaching classes for WITCC as well as teaching upper-level education classes for UNI while based on the Sioux City campus. 
University of Iowa Brings Writers Workshop to Harlan

The program provided an opportunity especially for youth to develop writing samples and have them evaluated by a University of Iowa poet and poet.

Emergency Medical Provider Training in Harlan

The system and trainers provide high-fidelity simulated health care emergencies to enhance the skills of providers around the state. University of Northern Iowa Conducts Western Iowa Tour

The delegation included professionals from the College of Business, the College of Education, and the Department of Technology. The UNI representatives met with community college advisors at each institution, as well as provided information, food, and UNI "swag" for prospective students.



University of Northern Iowa Engagement in Council Bluffs

The University of Northern Iowa has increased its engagement with the residents of Council Bluffs and southwest Iowa.
